

Instruction For Site Staff For Receiving Used Cooking Oil

Identification of Used Cooking Oil

Used Cooking Oil is vegetable oil which has been used in the cooking or frying process. Used Cooking Oil ranges in colour from yellow through to brown. This Used Cooking Oil is the only oil that can be poured into the Living Fuels oil collection tank.

Used Engine Oil (sump oil/mineral oil) is black in colour and **CANNOT** be mixed with Used Cooking Oil. Used Engine Oil **CANNOT** be poured into the Living Fuels oil collection tank.

Engine Oil – Black in colour – **CANNOT** be poured into tank



Cooking Oil – Yellow/Brown in colour – **CAN** be poured into tank

Process For Receiving

- 1) We recommend that members of the public are not allowed to pour Used Cooking Oil into the tank themselves, rather it should be handed to site staff or left besides the tank
- 2) We further recommend that the tank remains locked at all times to prevent members of the public pouring oil into the tank
- 3) Once identified as Used Cooking Oil, site staff should pour the oil into the tank
- 4) When pouring, we recommend site staff are familiar with the Living Fuels method statement for pouring Used Cooking Oil safely

Environmental Protection

- 1) Any minor accidental spillage should be dealt with by use of appropriate spill kit materials (granules, logs etc) , swept up, bagged and disposed of as per the site requirements.
